From April 19, every Wednesday: Cycling for the fourth graders

The preparation for the bicycle test for our fourth graders will take place every Wednesday until 17.05.2023 (test day) at the traffic practice area (Friedrich-Ebert-Str. 86; 95448 Bayreuth). As soon as the shuttle arrives, the children will take the bus to the traffic training location. Please be at school with your child at 7:45 am. You are also welcome to bring your child directly to the traffic training area.



Illness and school attendance - reporting illnesses

If a child shows symptoms of illness, we ask that you keep your child home.



Your child must be symptom-free for 24 hours before returning to school

(examples: • fever-free for 24 hours • your child has not had to vomit in the last 24 hours).

A confirmation of illness by the doctor (from the 3rd day of illness) is not mandatory. However, we will gladly take this confirmation if you had to present your child to the pediatrician for clarification of the illness.



Please inform us immediately if a child is suffering from one of the infectious diseases listed below:

- Whooping cough • Viral flu • Scarlet fever • Measles • Mumps • Rubella • Ringworm
- Chicken pox, • Hepatitis A/B.

This is to ensure that we do not put other children and colleagues at risk.

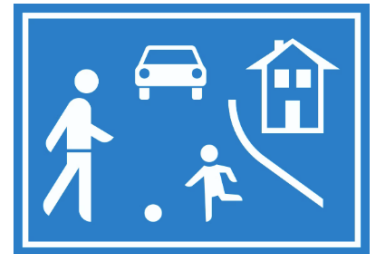
Parking and speed in the area of the parking lot and the schoolyard.

During pick-up, the school parking lot is very congested at certain peak times. We ask that you park in a space-saving manner.

Please do not enter the school yard until the parking spaces in front of the school are full. You are welcome to ring the school gate if it is still closed around 2pm.

Please drive slowly or at walking speed in the area of the parking lot in front of the school and on the schoolyard. Children are playing there!

Please be considerate of each other in the parking lot. It is not necessary to park longer in the morning, as children should also be encouraged to go to school on their own to support their independence. Of course, it is different on days when your child has a lot of luggage and you need to help them carry it.



Please comply with the submission deadlines

Occasionally, we require responses from you regarding registrations, questionnaires, and also monetary amounts by a specific deadline. We kindly ask you to strictly adhere to the submission deadlines.
